



Beginnings: Womens Community Projects Mullingar

- Mullingar like most other Irish towns was in the grip of recession, and suffering from high levels of unemployment.
- Many of the women and families Sr Finbarr came in contact with were struggling and trying to make ends meet.
- Sr Finbarr identified a need for a community centre or meeting place where these women could meet during the day, socialise and learn new skills in order to improve the quality of their lives and that of their families.
- ► The seeds were sown for a group which would grow and develop into Women's Community Projects Mullingar.
- Over the years the WCP Mullingar has grown, diversified and expanded in response to needs identified in the community and funding available. It is now home to one of the largest training and development centres and childcare facilities in the country.
















Childcare Programme


Mullingar Community Counselling

- Referral to appropriate services when needed










Community Employment (CE) Programme







